

Table Summary of New Source Review/General Regulation Updates proposed amendments

Article and Section	Proposed Updates
Articles I, II, IV, V, VI, X, CFS	Formatting improvements for consistency among Articles in SRCAA Regulation I; clarification edits to improve ease of use, understanding, and improved readability of the Articles; correct typographical and spelling errors; remove obsolete text; update citing; and updates to improve consistency between local regulations and state and federal regulations. The table below highlights additional proposed amendments.
1.01 - Policy	Update text to improve consistency with state and federal requirements and SIP approvability
1.04 – General Definitions	Modify definitions to improve consistency with state Chapter 173-400 definitions and federal clean air act definitions. Number definitions to provide consistency with other Articles in Regulation I. Add several definitions: air pollution episode, approval order, BART, brake horsepower, bubble, daylight hours, director, electronic means, excess emissions, executive director, facility, fuel burning equipment, HAP, heat input, like-kind replacement, maintenance area, malfunction, multiple chambered incinerator, NAICS, owner/operator, ppmw, PM2.5, PM2.5 emissions, portable source permit application, shutdown, Spokane Regional Clean Air Agency, stack-height, standard cubic foot of gas, startup, vent. Remove several definitions no longer needed: air contaminant source, certified observer, class I area, federal class I area, federal land manager, major modification, major stationary source, net emissions increase, new stationary air contaminant source, significant, temporary stationary source. Move procedural closure text from 1.04 to Article IV. Move upset condition definition from Article II to 1.04.
1.05 – Acronym Index	Add new section to assist readers in understanding various acronyms and measurement abbreviations
2.02 – Control Officer’s Duties and Powers	Add new subsection (J) to explain source records requirement
2.07 – Status of Orders of Appeal	Update with 2004 repeal information
2.09 – Source Tests	Remove definitions no longer needed, move “malfunction” to Article I; reorder subsections; include email as an allowable form of communication; expand test methods for clarification and SIP approvability; remove combustion tests since they are only required within an Order of Approval
2.13 – Federal and State Adoption by Reference Date	Add a single point adoption by reference date for both state and federal rules; add clarification text for federal rules for administrator and reports
2.14 – Washington Administrative Codes	Update adoption by reference to show what SRCAA is adopting by reference, rather than what SRCAA is excluding
2.16, 2.17, 2.18, 2.19 –Federal Adoptions by Reference Sections	Add new sections to adopt federal rules by reference
4.01 – Registration Required	Add new subsections explaining purpose and program components for clarification and to improve consistency with state requirements
4.02 – General Requirements for Registration	Restructure section; simplify text; add new subsections for fees, operation and maintenance plan; move closure requirements to 4.05
4.03 – Registration Exemptions	Update text to provide clarity on what is exempt from registration and exemption requirements

4.04 – Stationary Sources and Source Categories Subject to Registration	Rename Exhibit R to Section 4.04; restructure from one long list of sources and activities, to grouping five categories, state requirements, local requirements, operation type, equipment type, toxic air pollutants, to improve ease of use by the agency staff and regulated sources. Adding new General Order of Approval option. Update list to include source categories that agency has been registering but were not specified in Exhibit R: source categories to uncontrolled emission rates - distilleries, general surface coating operations that only use non-spray application methods, non-perchloroethylene dry cleaning operations, fume hoods, plasma or laser cutters, welding, brazing or soldering operations; and operation types - alternative commercial fuel production facilities, Portland cement production facilities
4.05 – Closure of a Stationary Source or Emissions Unit	Add new section; move closure procedural text from Sections 1.04 and 4.02 into 4.05 to improve ease of use and understanding
5.01 – Definitions	Update with 2004 repeal information
5.02 – New Source Review Applicability and When Required	Rework section to improve flow and clarity; add new subsections for purpose and applicability; change name of Notice of Intent (NOI) application to a Portable Source Permit (PSP) application; clarify text on when an Notice of Construction (NOC) or PSP is required; and improve consistency with state and federal requirements; and update exemption subsection to provide clarity on what is exempt from new source review and exemption requirements
5.03 – NOC & PSP Fees	Simplify text
5.04 – Information Required	Clarify what the source must provide so that the agency can make a determination; improve consistency with state and federal requirements
5.05 – Public Involvement	Updates to clarify noticing; comment period and hearing requirements; improve consistency with state and federal requirements
5.06 – Application Completeness Determination	Updates to clarify application completeness requirements
5.07 – Processing NOC Applications for Stationary Sources	Update subsection (A) to improve consistency with state and federal requirements; clarify criteria that must be met for approval of NOC applications and steps for the agency to take when a determination has been made. Improve the flow of subsection (B) and include steps for agency to take when a determination has been made
5.08 – Portable Sources	Change NOI to PSP; and simplify the permitting requirements for a portable source eliminating requirement to first obtain a NOC prior to obtaining an NOI, simplifying the process for businesses; update non-road engine requirements; update exemption subsection to provide clarity on what is exempt from PSP and exemption requirements
5.09 – Operating Requirements for Order of Approval and Permission to Operate	Simplify operation and maintenance and compliance subsections; remove text that is housed in 5.07; add new subsection (C) with operating requirements for internal combustion engines
5.10 – Changes to an Order of Approval or Permission to Operate	Simplify text; add transfer of ownership information that was housed in Section 5.02; clarify change in conditions text
5.11, 5.12, 5.13, 5.14, 5.15	Simplify text and improve readability

6.04 – Emission of Air Contaminant: Detriment to Person or Property	Subsection (B) updates to improve consistency with state requirements and SIP approvability
6.06 – Emission of Air Contaminants or Water Vapor Detriment to Persons or Property	Repeal, duplicative of 6.04(C) which replaced 6.06
6.07 – Emissions of Air Contaminant Concealment and Masking Restricted	Update to improve consistency with WAC 173-400-040(8) and SIP approvability
6.09 – Exceptions to this Article	Update with 2004 repeal information
6.12 – Reserved	Update reserve information
6.13 – General Surface Coating	Remove (H) compliance schedule
6.15 – Standards for Control of Particulate Matter on Unpaved Roads	Align (A) applicability text to be the same as 6.14(A)
10.02 – Fees and Charges Required	Update (C) text to excluded AOP from round up to nearest dollar requirements
10.06 – Annual Registration and Annual Air Operating Permit (AOP) Fees	Clarification updates; add consolidated to fee schedule
10.07 – Notice of Construction (NOC) and Portable Source Permit (PSP) Application for Approval Fees	Change NOI to PSP; add consolidated to fee schedule; change recent to preceding; update greater/less than symbols to words
10.08 – Miscellaneous Fees	Change NOI to PSP; add consolidated to fee schedule; change “recent” to preceding; update citing
10.11 – Oxygenated Gasoline	Update with 2005 repeal information
10.13 – Outdoor Burning	Update citing; add consolidated to fee schedule; change recent to preceding
CFS 10.07 – Notice of Construction (NOC) and Portable Source Permit (PSP) Fees	Change NOI to PSP; update greater/less than symbols to words; clarify case-by-case text and move to top of section
