

August 26, 2015 Asbestos Updates: Mobile Homes & OOSFR Load Supporting Structures

Moving a structure requires [Demolition Notification](#) to Spokane Clean Air. However, as of September 2, 2014, Spokane Clean Air no longer requires mobile homes that will remain intact during transport to submit Notification.

A mobile home (also trailer, trailer home, house trailer, static caravan, caravan) is a prefabricated structure, built in a factory on a permanently attached chassis before being transported to site (either by being towed or on a trailer).

In addition, Owner Occupied Single Family Residence (OOSFR) renovations/repairs that affect any load-supporting structural member (e.g., removal of a load supporting beam) need not file a demolition notification. (Section 9.02 M). Keep in mind that Asbestos Survey requirements (Section 9.03) remain applicable.
