Reminder - Windstorm Asbestos Waivers

The November 17th windstorm caused considerable damage to many structures in Spokane County. In response to this incident, Spokane Clean Air issued an Order Declaring Emergency due to Windstorm that waives select asbestos notification fees and waiting periods for Notices of Intent through March 31, 2016.
