#### **Asbestos Updates Topic #7:**

**In an effort to improve the understanding of local asbestos regulations, Spokane Clean Air will continue the Asbestos Updates service with a short monthly email that has 1-2 asbestos related tips.**

The Asbestos Updates service began in April 2015, with a series of bi-monthly email messages. The emails highlighted information and tips related to the 2014 asbestos regulation changes. With the launch of the service, Spokane Clean Air also sent out a communications survey to area asbestos service providers to find out what asbestos information they needed, the preferred form of communication, and how often the communications should occur. **The survey results showed a preference to continue the Asbestos Updates service, with short emails (1-2 tips), sent once a month.**
