Asbestos Updates Service Topic #4:

Roofing Projects:

- Asphalt shingles were removed as a suspect asbestos-containing material. (Section 9.02.H & Z)

Spokane Clean Air has been asked, "Do I still need an asbestos survey for a roofing project?" This change does not remove the requirement to obtain an asbestos survey for other building materials disturbed during a roofing project, for example, roofing felt, paper, patching compounds, and caulking.

- Requirements and exceptions for nonfriable asbestos-containing roofing were clarified. (Sections 9.02.E, 9.02.F, 9.02.R, 9.04.A.7.b, 9.07 & 9.08.B)
