Spokane Clean Air strives to recognize local businesses for the work they do to reduce air emissions and improve air quality in our community.

Every two years, we recognize businesses that are meeting local air quality requirements with "silver" level recognition, as well as those who are going above and beyond requirements to improve air quality in our community with "gold" level recognition.

Recognition includes a window decal to display at your facility, listing in Spokane Clean Air's newsletters and website. Plus, Gold level receives a certificate presented by our Board of Directors and listing on a print ad in a local newspaper.

To receive recognition, your business must meet the criteria listed below. Check the box if you have met the criteria and sign the back of this form. If applying for gold level, complete both sides of this form and sign.

**Level One - Silver:**

- My facility has not been issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) by Spokane Clean Air in the last two calendar years (2017, 2018) and during the most recent inspection of my facility
- My Annual Registration Form is complete and submitted to Spokane Clean Air by the required due date for the two most recent data collection cycles. (2018, 2019)
- My Annual Registration fees were submitted to Spokane Clean Air by the required due date during the two most recent billing cycles. (2018, 2019)

**Level Two - Gold:**

- Must qualify for level one, plus:
- My facility has not been issued a Corrective Action (CA) by Spokane Clean Air in the last two calendar years (2017, 2018) and during the most recent inspection of my facility
- My facility has implemented at least two measures that go "above and beyond" air quality requirements (provide detail on back and see examples)
