3. PRODUCER (PRODUCTION) INFORMATION

Producers are LCB licensed operations that propagate, grow, harvest, or trim marijuana to be processed.

Production occurs in a fully enclosed building that is permanently affixed to the ground, has permanent rigid walls, a roof that is permanent and non-retractable, and doors. Hoop houses, temporary structures, or other similar structures are not considered indoor.**

Control of environmental conditions means modifying surroundings to facilitate plant growth, and may include, but is not limited to; lighting, temperature, relative humidity, and carbon dioxide levels.
- Outdoor Marijuana Production.**
Production occurs on an expanse of open or cleared ground (no structure of any kind), during Spokane County's customary outdoor growing season, without control of environmental conditions.
- Other Marijuana Production.**
Production that is not Indoor or Outdoor as defined above. Examples of Other Marijuana Production include production in hoop houses, temporary structures, or other similar structures. Existing Other Marijuana Producers in operation prior to March 1, 2018, who wish to continue operating as an Other Producer, must apply for a production exemption by November 5, 2018.
