Spokane Clean Air is very interested in recognizing the work that you and other local businesses do to reduce air emissions and improve air quality in our community.

Every two years, businesses in our registration program can apply for silver or gold recognition. Those meeting local air quality requirements receive silver-level recognition and those who go "above and beyond" the minimum air quality requirements earn gold-level recognition.

Recognition includes a window decal to display at your facility, a shout-out in our newsletters and on our website. In addition, gold level businesses are presented a certificate by our Board of Directors and listed on a print ad in a local newspaper.

To receive recognition, your business must meet the criteria listed below. Please check the boxes that apply and sign the back of this form. If applying for gold, complete both sides of this form and sign. We will review each form received, verify the information and inform you of your status by May 15.

**Below are examples of measures that go “above and beyond” air quality requirements** to assist you in the kinds of activities we are looking for that you need to describe in the spaces above.

**Energy Efficiency examples:**

- Installed lighting, heating, cooling, water heating
- Upgraded equipment to improve operational efficiencies
- Other (e.g. smart thermostats/lighting control, upgraded building insulation, etc.)

**Process/ Product changes, source reduction, material substitution examples:**

- Switched to water-based paints/coatings
- Invested in new equipment that reduced waste (e.g. still recovery, etc.)

**Transportation-related examples:**

- Offered incentives to employees to use commute options to get to work, such as discounted bus passes, alternate work schedules, ridesharing, bike lockers, etc.
- Instituted a No-Idle policy for company vehicles (for “No Idling” signage, contact SRCAA)
- Invested in cleaner fleet vehicles
- Added additional, voluntary dust control measures
